Eric Harris brought up concerns regarding pursuits from other jurisdictions. Chief Connally answered with how these are handled by our agency. Marty Novak requested a status update on the radio upgrade including changing over to encryption. Chief Connally answered this as well. Marty Novak also brought up questions about private citizens registering their security camera systems with the police department. This was answered by the chief as well.

ITEM #4 Interaction with Police Department

Chief Connally provided stats related to our most recent helicopter operations. He also provided funding updates on our various community outreach programs. The Chief also gave an update on our homeless community projects including Mosaic's urban mission program.

Chief Connally briefly addressed an errant Metropolitan Area study that was being circulated again and explained what the numbers meant. He also discussed the new Ring Doorbell initiative and the department's involvement with that. Chief Connally also discussed a bill being prepared for council that would allow uncharged state felonies to be referred to city court. Chief Connally concluded with a presentation on this quarter's crime stats.

Sgt. Jason strong provided a presentation on the department's UAV program. He explained their capabilities, and demonstrated our current models.
