EMERGENCY BILLS FOR PASSAGE:

A Bill (#850-18) sponsored by Mayor McMurray authorizing an amendment to the Cell Phone Program budget in the amount of \$30,000.00 to provide debris removal and portable restroom facilities to mitigate the effect of the Contrary Creek flood.


A Bill (#851-18) sponsored by Mayor McMurray amending Chapter 7 "Buildings and Building Regulations" of the Code of Ordinances to adopt a new section 7-10, titled "Limited temporary license exemption" to allow electrical, plumbing, and mechanical work on flood-impacted residential properties by contractors licensed in other United States jurisdictions.

RESOLUTION FOR ADOPTION:

A Resolution (#852-18) sponsored by Mayor McMurray authorizing open burning in accordance with the requirements stated in Section 24-12 of the Code of Ordinances through August 16, 2020.
