Call to Order.

ITEM #1 – Approval of minutes

ITEM #2 – Plumbing test

Plumbing test from June 4, 2019 we had two people take the test. They passed and were very impressed with our testing. We had one taking the test at the same time as our meeting. Scott Helsel stated that he was trying to get two board members, Ronnie Swope and Jim Hoover. They are in the process of filling out the membership applications. Hopefully by next meeting we can have a full board.

ITEM #3 – Test changes

After we have full board it is suggested that we review the test for plumbing and revise it. Quick closing shut off valves or hammer restor are not on the test but are something that they should know. Need to take garbage disposals off the test as the City does not have a policy to install them. Grease interceptors are another item that should be looking into. State of Missouri and DNR policies are also need looking into as they should be on the test as well. Chairman has brought up the idea if the person taking the test does not pass as a master but does as a journeyman, they could get the journeyman license. Hayes made a motion and Veale second the motion Hayes – aye, Veale – ayes, Weets – aye. Also need to discuss and change the grading system. At one time you had to pass all three sections to get the license. Know they average out the sections to get the score.
