

Sec. 106 Posting for Public Comment



Rehabilitation of the Residence at 2901 Penn St.

The City of St. Joseph is seeking public comment on the proposed CDBG funded housing rehabilitation project on the residence located at 2901 Penn St. The scope of work for the exterior includes removing the existing deteriorated roof and replacing deteriorated sheathing then installing synthetic underlayment and 10 year architectural shingles. The roof work will include installing four colored low-profile vents, five-inch K-style guttering and three-inch downspouts. Foundation work includes the removal of a bulging section of a basement and replacing it with a concrete block wall and re-point deteriorated sections of the foundation.

Should you have any questions or comments about this project, including information on the design or any historical significance of the neighborhood, please send them to me in writing or by e-mail. In order for your information and/or comments to be considered they must be received by **no later than 5:00 pm Monday, April 20, 2020** so City staff can include them with the Sec. 106 report that will be sent to the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO).
